AR15/M4/M16 2-DAY ARMORERS COURSE

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must demonstrate proficiency in disassembly, reassembly, identification of parts, and troubleshooting mechanical deficiencies including corrective actions. Student must also score a minimum of 70% or higher on the Written Test.

Students are certified for three years from the date of the class.
